In following the guidelines for appropriate dress at Hampton School, please check the examples of **inappropriate** apparel. We ask that you review this list with your child.

- any article of clothing containing profanity
- any clothing promoting violence, hatred, or harassment
- tobacco, alcohol or beer logos
- devil or gang symbols
- sagging pants or pants that are excessively long as to be dangerous (pants should be secured at the waistline)
- see-through garments
- visible undergarments
- extremely short skirts or shorts
- bare midriffs, low-cut necklines, backless tops, tops with spaghetti straps, tube tops braless tops
- large chains
- wearing sunglasses, jackets, coats, head coverings, gloves and other outerwear in the building during the school day.
- any clothing that disrupts learning.

We expect students to dress *modestly* and with good taste. Students who are found to be in violation of these guidelines will be subject to disciplinary action as stated in the handbook. If necessary, parents will be notified and asked to supply appropriate clothing.
